Festival-goers turned up in record numbers for the largest edition of Montréal Pride to date, which took place from August 8 to 14, 2016. New shows, new artists and new partners were added to the festive mix to make the 2016 edition a resounding success, both in terms of the program and the number of visitors. Montréal's Gay Village and Place Émilie-Gamelin, the festival's main site, were alive with the energy of the **largest Francophone LGBTQ festival in the world**, setting the stage for an even more festive and colorful 11th anniversary edition next year.

Montréal Pride is proud to have become one of the major summer festivals in Montréal by presenting a variety of local and international artists and activities. The economic impact of the festival is undeniable for the city. Montréal Pride is happy to help make Montréal even more open to diversity and a prime destination for LGBTQ tourists from around the world. And Montréal Pride also serves as a beacon of hope for trans people and for international LGBTQ communities living with violence and injustice, so our mission is more relevant and necessary than ever.

An estimated total of **563.154 festival-goers** participated in the 10th edition.

Montréal Pride is very proud to have delivered a program that was diverse, inclusive and, for the vast majority of events, free. We offered nearly **125 activities** (a record) for all ages and interests, with, for example Kids' Day, Pride Day at La Ronde, Drag Superstars, events for women, a play, Literary Pride, conferences and sporting activities and, of course, many free shows and parties.

Who would have thought 10 years ago, that Montréal Pride would become one of the largest festivals in Québec? At once community-oriented, advocacy-driven and festive, the event manages to attract international talent, bring together people from the four corners of the world, bring hope to LGBTQ communities that continue to live with injustice around the globe and move our cause forward — all on a tight budget and with a program of events that's almost entirely free. Montréal Pride is the only event to offer major platform for visibility to oganizations involved in the LGBT community. To this end, Montréal Pride is a unifying body for the vast majority of LGBT orgnizations of Montréal and Québec.

- + To demystify and create awareness about the realities of the LGBTQ community in Montréal and Québec for the general public:
- + To work towards the advancement of LGBTQ human rights, both here and around the world:
- + To promote and participate in the work carried out by LGBTQ groups in Montréal and the province of Québec who are fighting against discrimination based on sexual orientation, gender identity and HIV status.
- + To offer the LGBTQ community in Montréal and the province of Québec a showcase and a platform for cultural expression;
- + To recognize and celebrate the social and legal advances made by the LGBTQ community in Montréal and the province of Québec through festive, social, political, community and advocacy activities;
- + To organize the largest LGBTQ gathering in the province each year;
- + To host festive, social, political, philanthropic, advocacy and community events throughout the year.

PRIMARY PROJECT

Each year, Montréal Pride holds a week of cultural and community activities, including the Pride Parade and Community Day, to celebrate in a festive way the advancements made by the LGBT community while raising awareness about the many issues that remain to be addressed in order to fight homophobia, both here and around the world. The Montréal Pride program of activities has three key components: community and human rights activities, cultural activities and festive events.


PARADE AND COMMUNITY DAY

ABOUT MONTRÉAL PRIDE

AN ESSENTIAL EVENT

Members of the LGBT community make up nearly 10% of the general population and are an integral part of the DNA in cities like Montréal. All major cities in the world have a Pride event – at least, all those where such gatherings are permitted. It is unthinkable to imagine Montréal without the Pride Parade. The support from all levels of government is essential, as is support from the private sector, the LGBT community and the general public. Montréal Pride is a unifying event that allows community organizations in the Montréal area to enjoy visibility in the eyes of the general population at least once a year. This allows the LGBT community to build awareness about social diversity, an essential element in our society, and about social advances and the challenges that remain on the road to true social acceptance.

WHAT DOES PRIDE LOOK LIKE AROUND THE WORLD?

Pride is a socio-political community and cultural event structured around two main activities: a Pride Parade and a Community Day. For cities like San Francisco, Toronto, New York, Madrid, Stockholm, Vancouver, San Diego, Rio de Janeiro and São Paolo, Pride is also one of the largest tourist events of the year.

A LEADER IN LGBT RIGHTS

Montréal Pride strives to remain at the forefront of the defense of LGBT rights. both here and around the world. Through its diverse program of activities and the hosting of international guests each year from countries where LGBT human rights are often violated. Montréal Pride is able to pursue its objective of raising awareness about LGBT human rights issues among the general public in the Montréal area and the province of Québec.



A remarkable presence was assured during Pride Toronto, at the kiosk during Fair Days (with 35 team members present), the Trans March on Friday and the Parade on Sunday with a contingent of 40 aerobic dancers plus banners and drag queens. We had created several pamphlets and distributed hundreds of Tourisme Montréal kisses besides offering festival-goers to participate in a contest (in partnership with VIA Rail and the Alt Hotel Montréal) for a three-day VIP trip for two Montréal Pride.

In London, Ontario, Montréal Pride was present at the Fierté Canada Pride conference.

In Las Vegas, Montréal Pride was also present to attend the InterPride Conference.

Members of the Montréal Pride team visited Mumbai and Delhi from May 18 to 30 to take part in discussions on the advancement of human rights. Among others, they also meet with the director of KASHISH, the Mumbai International Queer Film Festival, Sridhar Rangayan who has been included on the British Council's fiveFilms4freedom 2016 Global List of 33 inspiring people from around the world who use culture to promote equality and LGBT rights. The filmmaker and activist was also one of the Grand Marshals for Montréal Pride 2016.


