

PRIDE PARADE

AUGUST, SUNDAY 13TH 2023

GENERAL REGULATIONS

- A person responsible for the contingent must attend the Pride Parade coordination virtual meeting, on Tuesday, July 18th, 2023.
- Animals are only allowed in vehicles or on floats. No animal must walk in the Pride Parade.
- The consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited during the Pride Parade and at the assembly site.
- No soliciting is allowed during the Pride Parade.
- Fierté Montréal must approve each group's sponsors and reserves the right to refuse them. The addition of a logo other than that of the participating group is subject to an additional fee.
- Scantily clad marching is permitted, but genitalia must not be visible.
- No weapons are allowed, including firearms.

REFUNDS

No refund of registration fees for the Pride Parade will be made except if new health restrictions are enacted. It will then be possible to request either a refund, a deferral of your registration to the 2023 edition of the Festival, or to donate it to Fierté Montréal.

ECO RESPONSIBILITY

- All distribution of promotional items or printed materials is prohibited.
- Each group is responsible for the waste generated by their contingent before, during, and after the Pride Parade.
- All groups must comply with the Ville de Montréal's waste sorting requirements.
- Failure to comply with these regulations may jeopardize the group's future participation in the Pride Parade and the Festival Fierté Montréal.

VEHICLES

- Only registered vehicles are allowed in the assembly area.
- Only eco-friendly vehicles are allowed in the Pride Parade; that is: electric, hybrid, and biofuel vehicles.
- All drivers must have the necessary permits to operate the vehicle legally and safely.
- All groups marching with a float must designate a person in charge of the vehicle, and four (4) people must always guard the vehicle at its wheel height (both in the front and rear axles) during the parade.
- The floats must be operated in a safe manner and their design must not in any way jeopardize the safety of marchers or the crowd.
- For safety reasons, the wheels of the float must be hidden by wooden panels. These panels must hide the wheel for at least 30 centimeters from the ground.
- All generator-equipped vehicles must carry a chemical fire extinguisher.
- The maximum dimensions of any vehicle are 48 feet (14.5 m) long, 10 feet (3 m) wide, and 13 feet (4 m) high from the ground.
- The cab of the flatbed truck must not include a sleeping berth.
- Vehicles must be at the departure site at the specified time and location. Vehicles must be cleared for

compliance and safety before taking part in the Parade. Only vehicles in compliance with the instructions are allowed to participate in the parade.

- A 42-inch (1.1 m) high guardrail must be installed on the float if participants are present on it during the parade.

HARASSMENT PREVENTION AND NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

People and organizations acknowledge that they adhere to the following principles: Fierté Montréal Pride supports equal access and prohibits any form of harassment or discrimination regarding cultural affiliation, ethnic or national origin, beliefs, political convictions, income, sexual or romantic orientation, language, gender identity or expression, age except as provided by law, pregnancy, disability or use of a means to palliate that disability, neurodivergence, intersex status, relationship configuration, HIV/AIDS status, or having received a pardon.

Fierté Montréal Pride is committed to providing an environment free of bullying and harassment. In a collective effort, Fierté Montréal Pride expects everyone involved in Fierté Montréal Pride activities to be proactive in preventing harassment and bullying. No abusive behavior of any kind towards Fierté Montréal Pride staff, volunteers or members, and vice-versa, will be permitted. This includes verbal, physical, sexual and psychological abuse.

Fierté Montréal Pride reserves the right to refuse any entity that does not respect the values of the organization. Any person, organization or entity that promotes racism, xenophobia, homophobia, lesbophobia, transphobia, biphobia, serophobia or geopolitical and religious conflicts will automatically be refused and will not be allowed to participate in Fierté Montréal Pride activities.

ALL PARTICIPATION IN THE PARADE IS SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF FIERTÉ MONTREAL.
